Generating Reports in the LMS

We know that since launching the upgraded LMS, many of you have encountered issues related to running reports on your users' activity. TTN, the LMS platform provider, is developing a completely new reporting feature that will be available in the New Year. While they develop this new feature, they have added some static reports to ensure you are able to access the information you need. SGR encourages everyone to use the following two reports to gather data in your LMS:

- Assigned Static Report Includes all user assignments that have been assigned but not completed
- Completed Static Report Includes all user completions (both assigned and unassigned)
